



## LOSER PANORAMA ROAD

The Loser Panorama road is rightly considered to be a construction marvel in terms of alpine roads. Travelling along the mountain road and enjoying its beautiful views in a bus, car, on a motorbike or on a bicycle is impressive even in terms of the dimensions. On the way up the mountain, you travel 9 kilometres, around 15 bends and more than 750 metres up. The Loser Plateau with its clear skies features not only a free car park but also a great view over the Ausseerland area and the surrounding mountains. The panoramic view over the Niedere Tauern, the beautiful Dachstein glaciers and the snow-covered peak of the Großvenediger is absolutely awe-inspiring, even if you're already used to wonderful mountain views.

But the fun starts here for ambitious mountaineers:

In summer, visitors and hikers can enjoy the "Loseralm" mountain restaurant. It is a good rest spot, as well as a starting point for lots of walking paths, hiking routes and mountain tours at various levels of difficulty.

The new "Sophie" via ferrata is especially popular amongst young people, beginners and people getting back into climbing. The sporty and dynamic "Sisi" panorama via ferrata provides unparalleled views. The view over the famous "Loserfenster" is unforgettable and this extraordinary rock formation can be accessed via the hiking trail in around 45 minutes. Finally, the "Omunduntn" high-rope park at the Loser Arena is a great way of burning off some excess energy.

So, at the end of a day exploring the Loser region, you are guaranteed to have lots of unforgettable memories in your head, heart and on your camera.
